| Category 11A | Products with intended skin contact but minimal transfer of fragrance to skin from inert substrate without UV exposure | 0.90% |
| Category 11B | Products with intended skin contact but minimal transfer of fragrance to skin from inert substrate with potential UV exposure | 0.90% |
| Category 12 | Products not intended for direct skin contact, minimal or insignificant transfer to skin | 100% |
